Europa Oil and Gas will be submitting a planning application in November to erect a

30-METRE

(100-feet) drilling rig on land between the Cinder Track and Cleveland Way, just metres away from houses in Burniston

This first stage of drilling process will last

37 WEEKS

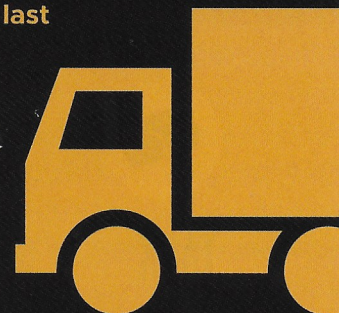
 (259 days)

If sufficient gas in the Cloughton gas field is present, an application will be made for

20 MORE YEARS

of drilling, + the building of 4 or 5 drilling rigs in Burniston and more in Cloughton to create
